Dear Families

As we approach the end of this academic year, I am writing to update you on some recent and exciting developments and also some changes which will take place when students return in September.

New extra-curricular clubs and activities programme

I am delighted that from September we will be offering many more extra-curricular clubs, classes and activities. More than 60 clubs will be on offer in the new year, including all of the traditional activities but this year we will be broadening our offer to include more creative options such as jewellery making, games programming, and performing arts.

All of these activities will be offered free of charge and be available to students in all year groups after school from Tuesday – Friday. I have attached a full booklet with an overview of these activities. In September, we will talk to all students about how they can sign up for these clubs.

Breakfast club

We have trialled a breakfast club the last half term which seemed to work well. This did not run during the examination season, however will resume in September.

There will be provision for all students to attend the Academy from 7:45am each morning free of charge and be supervised by members of our staff with free cereal and toast provided. Other items such as bacon and sausage rolls/bagels and drinks will also be available for purchase. Breakfast club runs in the music hall and is accessible by the side door near to main reception.

Academy Uniform

Our Academy uniform reflects the Academy's long-standing tradition for academic excellence and high standards of which we are so proud. Academy uniform plays a vital role in contributing to the ethos of the Academy and setting the appropriate tone. We believe that by encouraging our students to dress smartly for school, we are building on the standards, discipline and professionalism that the young people we work with, will require in the world of work.

By wearing the Academy uniform, students at Waltham Toll Bar Academy demonstrate visually that they belong to the Academy community. Times of the Academy Day and 2023/24 calendar

To create opportunities and develop the confidence to excel – together, we have been working hard over recent months to improve the subject offer and our curriculum for all students. This has involved increasing the number of subjects students can choose for their GCSE and A Level study, as well as ensuring our approach to setting, grouping and supporting students is the best it can be.

We will also be moving away from lesson times of differing length (either 45 or 55 minutes) to five, one full hour lessons per day. We are confident that this will have a significant and positive impact on how students learn and make progress.

As a result of these changes, it will be necessary for the times of the school day to change slightly. This means a slightly earlier start each day for students. Students will also have a two-week timetable allowing us to offer greater opportunity and breadth in our curriculum. Details of the two-week timetable will be shared and explained in September when your child returns to the Academy.



Uniform expectations

Waltham Toll Bar Academy (WTBA) students are expected to wear:

- BLACK blazer with academy badge.
- Generic WHITE shirt Years 7/8, WHITE shirt or WHITE Blouse Years 9/10/11
- Academy tie RED tie for Years 7/8, BLUE tie for Years 9/10/11.
- BLACK tailored trousers or a WTBA branded knee length skirt.
- Generic plain BLACK or WHITE socks (no ribbons/bows) which cover the ankle / BLACK tights.
- Generic sensible plain BLACK shoes that can be polished (not trainers, canvas, fashion shoes or boots)
- Generic backpack which is big enough to hold an A4 file without it being folded as well as school books, essential learning equipment and PE kit (clutch/accessory/handbags not permitted)



Waltham Toll Bar Academy (WTBA) PE kit:

Compulsory:

- Waltham Toll Bar Academy polo shirt
- Waltham Toll Bar Academy shorts or skort
- Waltham Toll Bar Academy PE socks
- Training shoes
- Football boots and shin pads (Year 7/8 girls and all Years boys)

Optional:

- · Waltham Toll Bar Academy rugby shirt
- Waltham Toll Bar Academy quarter zip track top
- · Waltham Toll Bar Academy track pants
- BLACK / NAVY top and/or legging base layer to be worn underneath the kit
- WHITE sports socks (can be worn after the Easter holidays in replacement of WTBA PE socks)

We expect pupils to wear our uniform correctly. Wear it correctly means:

- Top button on shirt is fastened. Shirt is tucked in.
- Tie all the way up to the collar. Tie is down to the waist.
- · Skirt, if worn, at knee length and not rolled over.
